

Untreated disease can lead to dead spots that need to be reseeded or re-sodded in order to prevent weeds from taking over in those areas. The best looking fescue lawns get fungicide to remain green

Only remove 1/3 of the grass blade during a mow. If after mowing there are clumps, like in the picture above, either bag or mulch them in by mowing over the clippings again until you can't see them.
