



Late Summer Treatment On Your Lawn

Bermuda and Zoysia: These lawns are getting the last application of nitrogen for the season as well as their first application of weed preventer this fall. A couple of goodies we have in the mix are iron and bio stimulants to give the lawns an extra boost in color.

Fescue: It is time for fescue to be relieved from the stress of the summer heat. These lawns are receiving a blanket broadleaf weed control, spot spray of nutsedge, and our favorite granule fertilizer. The fertilizer is a blend of organic and synthetic nutrients.

Education: Seeding

Seeding season is HERE! Don't miss this prime window. Spring is NOT the ideal seeding time on fescue lawns because the seedlings won't mature before the summer heat; it will burn up the seedlings. The weather is soon to cool off. Fescue loves the cool weather and is getting ready to shine in all of it's glory. Having more predictable rains and cooler weather sets a seedling up for better chances of survival.

Having the proper equipment and selecting the right seed is crucial in long term success and beauty of the lawn. Not all varieties are made equal. We have put years into trialing various blends to select what works best in our area. DO NOT skimp on seed quality to save money. It will cost you much more in the long run.

Core Aeration

Core Aeration can really boost the health of a lawn. Why? Because when the aerator machine penetrates deep into the soil, it pulls out plugs (that look a lot like dog poop) of dirt. The holes allow for water and nutrients to get deep into the root zone and that in turn helps make a healthy lawn.

Although fescue lawns benefit from fall core aeration alone, it is the perfect time to overseed. Overseeding is needed to thicken a lawn and repair areas damaged and stressed from the summer.





Pro Tip: Add Dirt to Level Your Lawn

Do you have pot holes that swollow your foot or mower tires? Now would be the time to think about getting those spots levels with dirt and then preparing for any seed needs you may have.
